Searching for Newspaper Articles

1. Think of a specific ethical issue involving computers to research (for example: hacking, privacy, identity theft, etc.).
2. Brainstorm keywords or short phrases that best describe your topic. For example, if you want to find articles on ethical issues regarding computer hacking, you could try using keywords such as hacking, ethics, computer, internet, etc.
3. Enter different keywords into separate search boxes. If you use a phrase, try putting quotation marks around the phrase. To add additional search boxes, click the **(+) Add a row** button.

Example search:

computer	Anywhere except full text – N	
AND	ethics	Anywhere except full text – N
AND	"identity theft"	Anywhere except full text – N
+ Add a row		- Remove a row

To search within a specific publication, such as the New York Times, change the drop-down menu to the right to **Publication Title—PUB**. Here is another search example:

New York Times	Publication title – PUB	
Look up Publications		
AND	computer	Anywhere except full text – N
AND	hacking	Anywhere except full text – N
+ Add a row		- Remove a row

Search Tips

- When looking at your results, click on **Show Abstract** to get a summary of the article and see the subject keywords used in the article.
- Click on **Full Text** to access the full article.
